Infection Control Guidelines and Visiting Policy

- a. Once entering our hospital, please clean your hands with alcohol based handrub. For those with respiratory illness, he/she should wear a surgical mask.
- b. Visiting hours: 8:00a.m to 10:00p.m
- c. Recommend two visitors per patient at a time
- d. Advised to remove the surgical mask and clean your hands with alcohol based handrub before leaving our hospital

The following persons are not recommended to visit

- ✧ Persons with respiratory illness (e.g. cough, sore throat or difficulty in breathing) or fever
- ✧ Persons with chronic illnesses, immunocompromised disease and long term application of steroids
- ✧ Children under 12 years old
