H1N1 Influenza A - **Emergency** Response Level

Our hospital has activated the Emergency Response Level for Influenza Pandemic on 2 May 09 in response to the first confirmed case of the H1N1 Influenza A found in Hong Kong on 1 May, 2009.

We have adopted stringent Infection Control Measures to minimize the risk of cross-infection. The measures are as follows:

- a. 4 Triage Stations are located at
 1. Old Wing Main Entrance
 2. New Wing Main Entrance (next to Admission Office)
 3. Entrance to Out Patient Department
 4. Rear Car Park Entrance
- b. All Visitors & Visiting Doctors should undergo temperature screening before entering the hospital premises.
- c. All Patients /Customers should undergo temperature screening & registration before entering the hospital premises.
- d. All personnel of the hospital, visiting doctors, visitors & customers must maintain proper hand hygiene and wear a surgical mask on entering the hospital premises.
- e. Visiting hours: 8:00a.m. to 10:00p.m.
- f. Only two visitors per patient at a time are allowed.
- g. The Old Wing Main Entrance and Rear Car Park Entrance will be closed from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. The Entrance to the Out-patient Department will be closed from 11:00p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Please use the New Wing Main Entrance during the aforesaid period.
- h. Based on the reporting criteria set by the Centre of Health Protection, suspected cases of H1N1 Influenza A will be reported. These patients will be transferred to the designated hospitals of the Hospital Authority for further Clinical Management.

The following persons are not recommended to visit our hospital

- ✧ Those with Acute Respiratory illness (e.g. cough, sore throat or difficulty in breathing) or fever and History of recent travel (7days before onset of illness) to affected areas
- ✧ Those who have contacted patients suspected or confirmed with H1N1 Influenza A
- ✧ Children under 12 years old
- ✧ Pregnant women
